We honor indigenous people everywhere and are committed to providing assistance which contributes to their health and happiness. Strong Villages coordinates volunteer travel opportunities and partners with local organizations and health ministries to provide desperately needed medical and dental services to indigenous people all over the world.

CRITICAL NEEDS

THE NEED IS GREAT. OUR RESOLVE IS STRONGER.

Health care in Belize is socialized. The government provides one dentist to serve the 31,000 residents of Toledo District.

For optimal dental health, the World Health Organization recommends a dentist to population ratio of 1:7,500.

Access to the sole dentist is further obstructed by the lack of transportaion. 80% of the population lives in rural villages.

There is one hospital with 20 healthcare providers for the entire district of 31,000 people.

Of the four languages spoken in Belize, UNESCO classifies three as "Vulnerable" to "Severely Endangered".

STRONG TEAM

The seeds for Strong Villages were planted in a Belzean rainforest over 20 years ago. Lynn Bealer had been trekking into the jungle to provide essential care to indigenous populations since 1988. On assignment from ABC News, Jeff MacIntyre would journey into the jungle to do a story on Lynn in 2001. Just like a movie set, monkeys were howling, parrots squawking, insects buzzing. The scene was set for the two to meet.

At the time, neither knew what those seeds would yield. Both were there for different reasons, but shared a similar goal: Help the indigenous population of Belize. Lynn's method was to create a hands-on connection with the community. Jeff's tool for change was harnessing the power of media to raise awareness.

Over a decade later, the two reunited and Lynn shared a passion to create an organization to provide compassionate assistance for the indigenous.

Moved by the message, Jeff jumped at the opportunity to help Lynn bring this passion to life. 15 years after their sweaty jungle meeting, the seeds would sprout and Strong Villages began to grow.
